



[The Department of Economics, Management and Quantitative Methods \(DEMM\)](#) is seeking to expand in the fields of **Digital Business, Big Data and Information Systems**. For this reason, DEMM aims at recruiting a three-year post-doc in one of the above areas. The post-doctoral position has **little or no teaching** involved.

The University of Milan is a major research and teaching institution located in one of Europe's most thriving cities. It is ranked in the top 200 for Economics in the Shanghai Ranking of World Universities. According to RepEc, the Department of Economics, Management, and Quantitative Methods – DEMM is one of the top five departments of economics in Italy and in the top four percent in Europe. The recent Italian research evaluation exercise (VQR 2011-2014) placed DEMM among the top 10 departments in the area of economics, management and statistics in Italy.

The ideal candidate must:

- Have (or be close to completing) a PhD in a relevant field (management, economics, business studies, computer science, etc.);
- Be highly motivated and be able to demonstrate expert knowledge in the field;
- Particular attention will be given to candidates who possess **strong quantitative and/or qualitative analytical skills**;
- Possess a **promising research record**, ideally having published or be en route to publish contributions in excellent international journals;
- Show the potential to cooperate with the current members of the department in improving DEMM's research output and impact. DEMM's academics publish regularly in leading journals (*Organization Science, Research Policy* and *Industrial and Corporate Change*).
- Work or be interested to work in areas of research at the **intersection of data science (artificial intelligence, industry 4.0, blockchain, etc.) and economics/management/business studies** as DEMM has been the recipient of a generous competitive funding in the recent "Bando Dipartimenti di Eccellenza" grant, awarded by the Italian ministry of education (MIUR) and aimed at creating the [Centre of Excellence in Economics and Data Science \(CEEDS\)](#).

Gross salary: €30,000-40,000 according to experience per annum.
